Freedom of Speech (First Amendment)

Protects the right to express your opinions (no matter what they are) without punishment from the government.

Freedom of Religion (First Amendment)

Protects the right to choose and practice your religion.

Freedom of Press (First Amendment)

Protects the right of the media to report the news and spread information.

Freedom of Assembly (First Amendment)

Protects the right to gather peacefully with a group.

Right to Bear Arms (Second Amendment)

Protects the right of to own a gun to defend oneself.

Protection from Housing Soldiers (Third Amendment)

Protects the right to not house US soldiers in your home.

Protection from Unreasonable Searches **(Fourth Amendment)**

Protects people being searched by the police unless they have good reason (and a warrant from a judge) to do so.

Right to Due Process (Fifth Amendment)

Protects people accused of crimes from being punished without having a trial in court.

Protection from Double Jeopardy (Fifth Amendment)

Protects people from being punished twice for committing the same crime.

Protection from Cruel and Unusual Punishment (Eighth Amendment)

Protects people from being punished for committing crimes in very cruel ways.
